

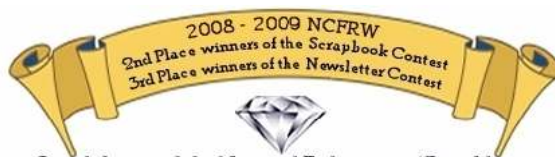

Staci Chiomento's in her last year at Methodist.

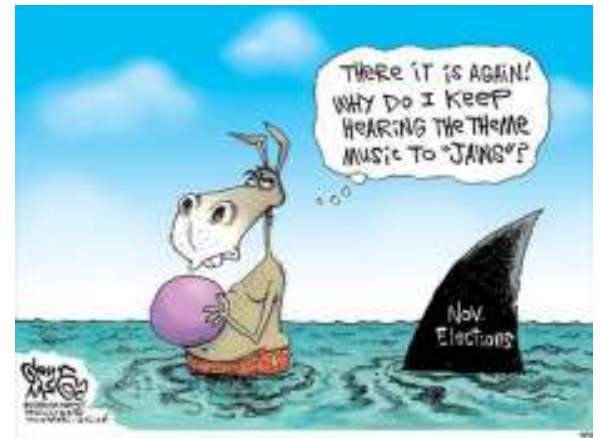
Sue Nading is now teaching at Flora McDonald Academy and Randy Nading is also teaching school this year.

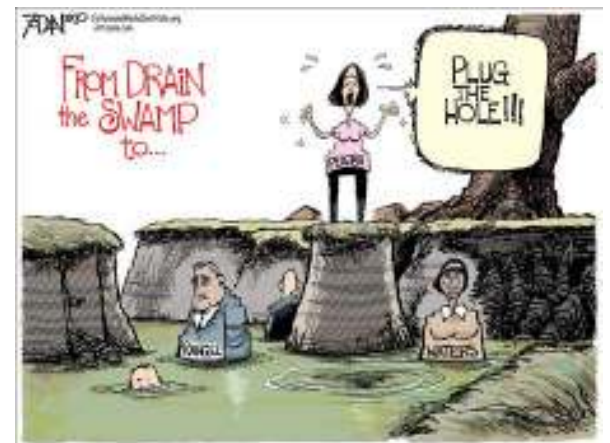
