Legislative News

Congress has recessed so that Senators and Congresspersons can go back to their constituents and campaign. Now, we must make sure that we help our candidates! Know the issues! Know your candidates! Talk to your neighbors and friends! Then VOTE! Ask everyone you know to vote beginning on October 14.

~Congress recessed without voting on the Bush Tax Cuts. Senator Kay Hagan is not for an across the board cut. CALL HER OFFICE!

~\$50B Jobs Bill for the building of railways and infrastructure as well as energy and will use only Union labor. What happened to stimulus monies? Watch this one.

~Ag Jobs Bill still in Committee. This is the bill that so many of us heard about with Colbert on the news. This is another Amnesty Bill through the back door! Rep. Zoe Lofgren (D) also said that she would like to introduce a bill to unionize farm workers nationally. One of the Democrats stated they admired Che Guevara for his organizational skills!!
